# Library Citizens Advisory Committee

## Purposes and Duties of Committee:

The purposes and duties of the Committee are to publicly discuss and make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors regarding:

- The expenditure of Library bond monies;
- The implementation and prioritization of Library plans and programs; and
- The efficiency and scope of Library operations and services to the public.

## Committee Membership:

The Committee shall consist of 17 voting members:

Each member of the Board of Supervisors shall appoint one member to the Committee and may give preference to individuals residing in his or her respective Supervisorial District.

The Board of Supervisors, through appointments recommended by the Rules Committee, shall appoint three members to the Committee subject to the following requirements:

One appointee shall be representative of senior citizens;

One appointee shall be representative of New Americans for whom English is a second language; and

One appointee shall be representative of youth and children who shall be between the ages of thirteen and twenty-three at the time of appointment.

The City Librarian shall appoint three members to the Committee, subject to the following requirements:

One appointee shall represent the interests of the San Francisco Unified School District and/or public education in San Francisco;

One appointee shall represent the interests of technology and/or user privacy; and

One appointee shall represent the interests of the disabled community.

All appointees must reside in San Francisco, use the facilities and services of SFPL, and be library cardholders in good standing. Appointments to the Committee by the Board of Supervisors shall not consist of full time Library employees, members of the Library Commission and Council of Neighborhood Libraries or any advisory body created by the Library Commission or City Librarian.
