# Check Out San Francisco Family Pass

- ▶ Created as joint project between SFPL & DCYF
- ▶ Launched April 2010
- ▶ Joint partnership between SFPL & DCYF
  - ▶ SF Recreation & Parks added in 2012
- ▶ 18 attractions and museums in San Francisco
- ▶ SFPL library card required for in-person checkouts at branches and Main
- ▶ Passes good for 1 use within 7 day period
- ▶ Restricted to families with children

- ▶ Created by Contra Costa County Library system
- ▶ SFPL partners with DCYF and SF Recreation & Parks Department
- ▶ 53 museums and attractions from around the Bay Area
- ▶ SFPL Library card required
- ▶ Online access and date-specific reservations
- ▶ Increased access for more San Franciscans
