

750 Brannan Street Leased Facility Update

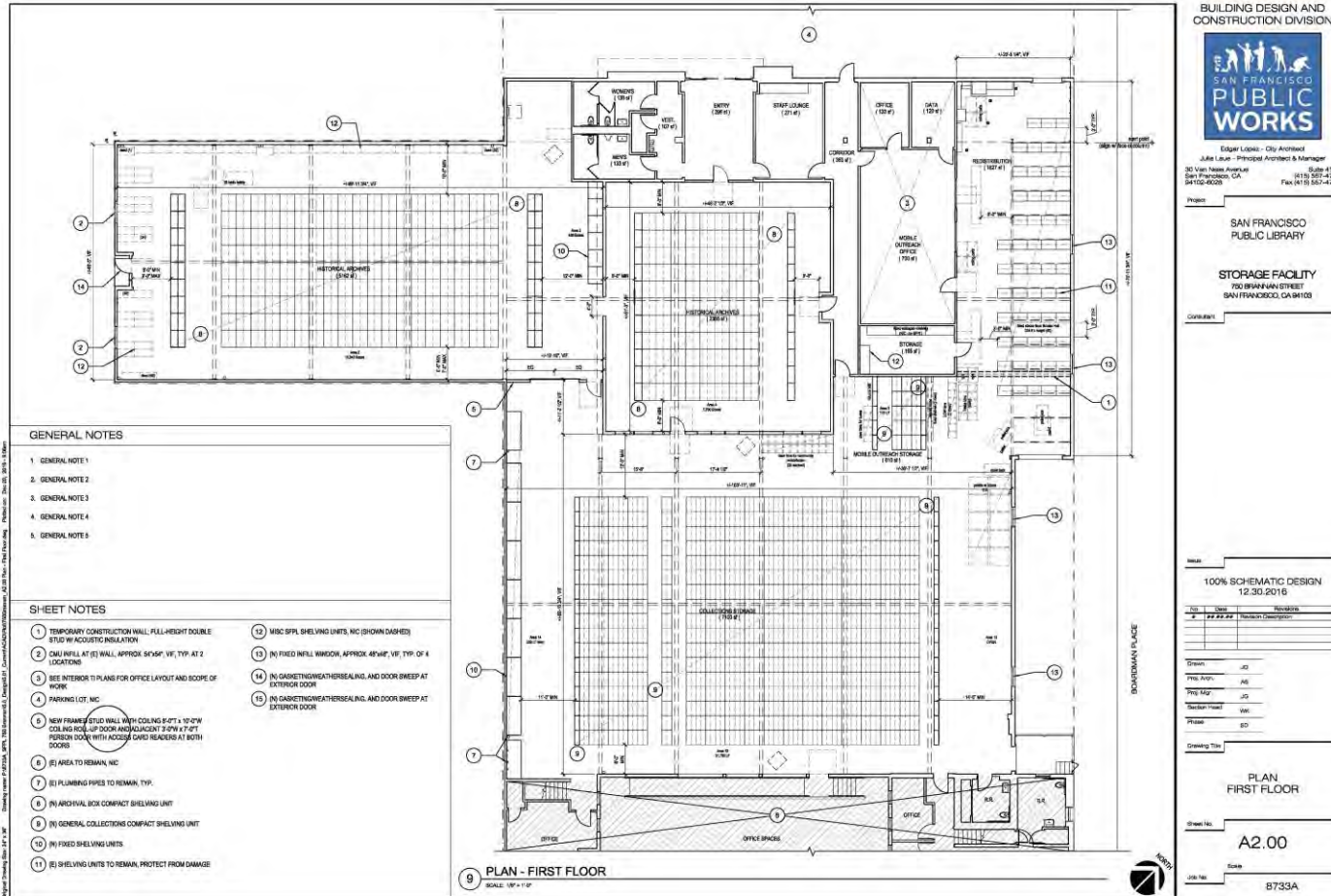


Background and Goals

- In late 2016, SFPL and Real Estate secured a warehouse location at 750 Brannan Street in order to provide:
 - Increased capacity for temperature and humidity controlled SF History archive storage
 - Dedicated office space and consolidated bookmobile parking for Mobile Outreach Services (MOS)
 - Upgraded shelving and processing space for Community Library Materials Redistribution program
 - Space for relocating collections out of Brooks Hall

Community Redistribution Program

- Community Redistribution has been fully functional at 750 Brannan since October 2017.
- Space provides greater accessibility for public community partners



Next Steps & Future Expansion

- San Francisco Public Works staff have produced designs to further develop 750 Brannan to include storage areas for SF History Archives & General Collections
- Storage areas will include compact shelving to efficiently utilize the space
- Schematic design complete, construction documents completed by Spring 2018
- Construction starts Fall 2018
- Ready for collections Winter 2019
