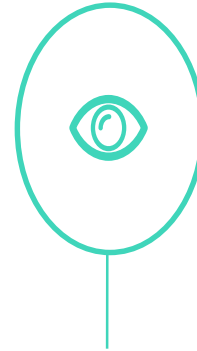
Presenter

Bringing programs to the library – the staff, the structure, the resources. Sometimes for pay, sometimes donated.



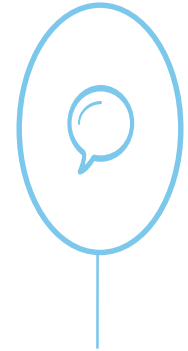
Collaborator

SFPL Connectivity

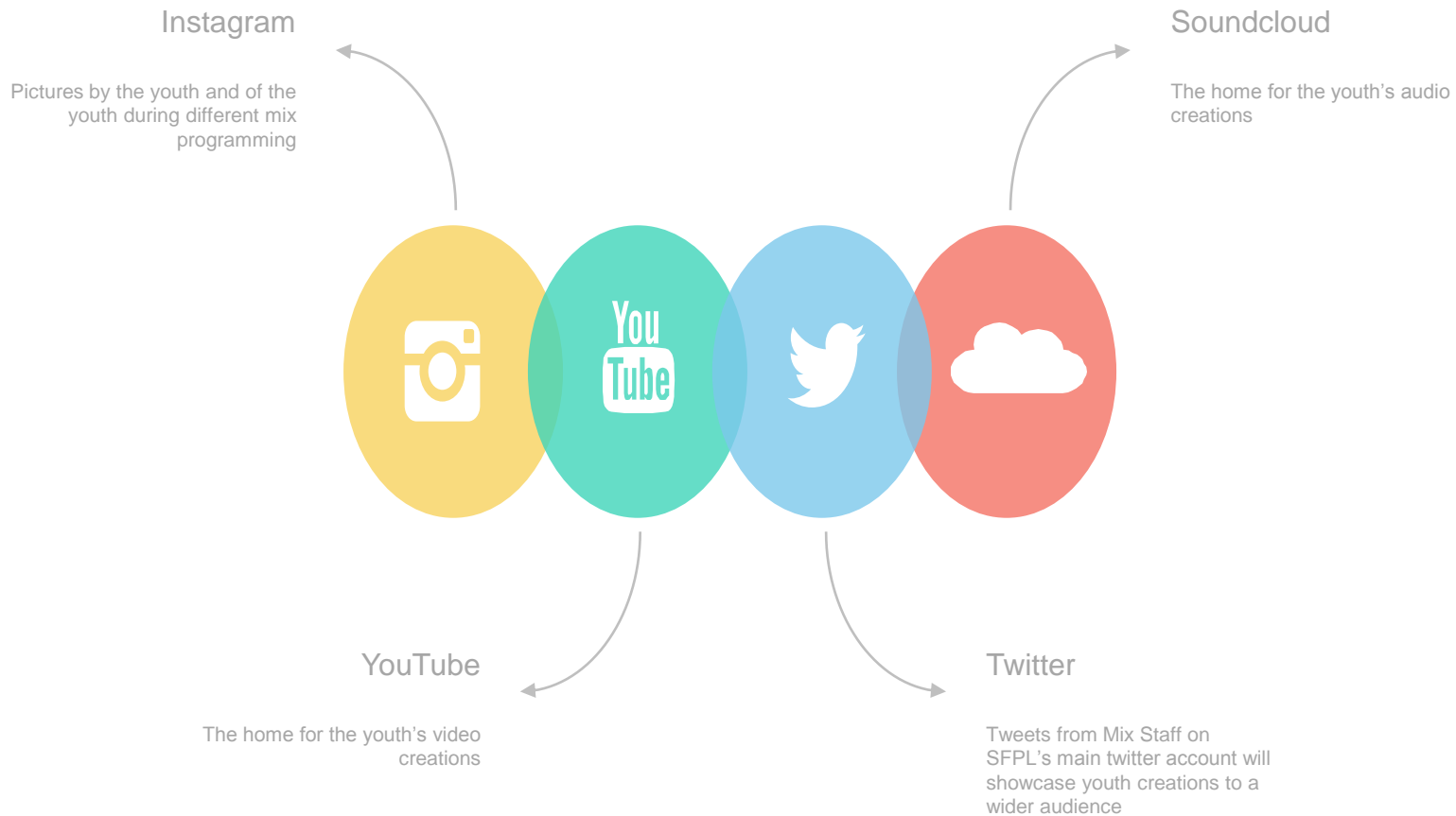
Programs will occur simultaneously across branches or virtually

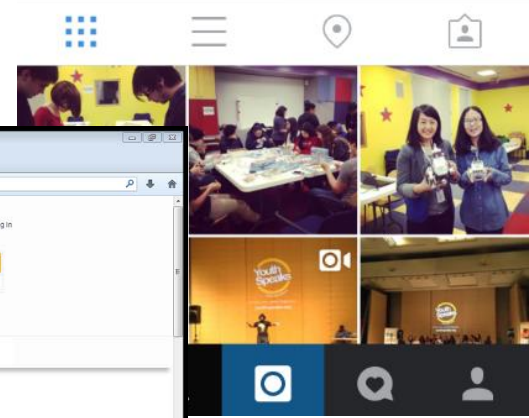

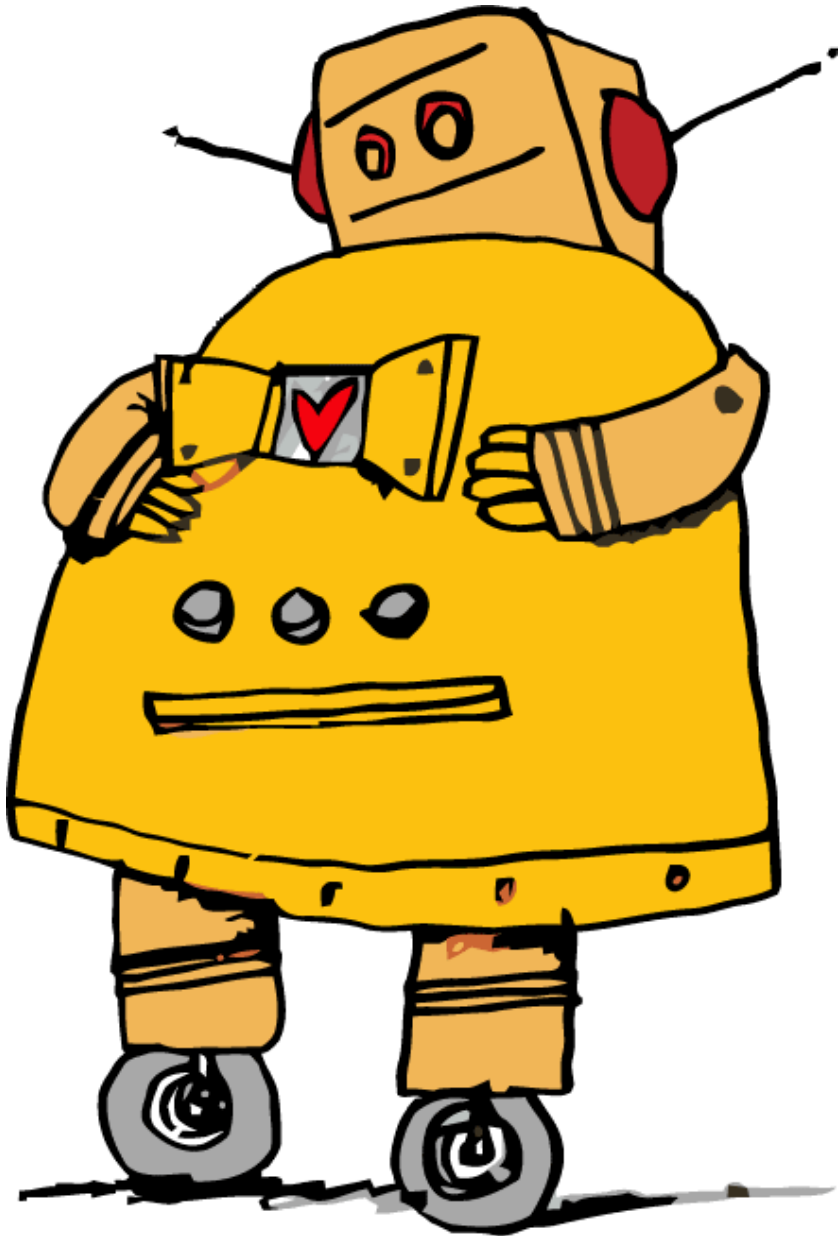
