Open Hours Assessment - Overview

- Library Preservation Fund est. 2008
(San Francisco City Charter, Section 16.109)
 - Maintain a minimum of 1,211 system-wide service hours per week
 - Review of service hours required every 5 years
 - Establish a community input process to provide feedback for determining service hours, including a mandated public hearing in each supervisorial district

Open Hours Assessment - Components

- Structured Patron Survey (sample size = 4,586)
 - Conducted late August to late September 2017
 - Representative cross-section of library patrons
 - Surveying during morning/daytime, late afternoon/evening hours, weekdays and weekends
 - Languages - English, Spanish, Chinese, Russian, Vietnamese, and Tagalog
 - Margin of error among SF population +/- 1.44%

Open Hours Assessment - Components (cont.)

- Public Input Survey (sample size=643)
 - Included attendees from public meetings as well as other patrons and the public who wished to provide input but were not included in the Structured Survey
 - Conducted late August to mid-November 2017
- Library Staff Survey (sample size=534)
 - Online survey - September 2017
 - Emphasis on public-facing staff - in order to obtain opinion on open hours from the staff who regularly **observe each branch's busiest and slowest times, etc.**

Open Hours Assessment - Components (cont.)

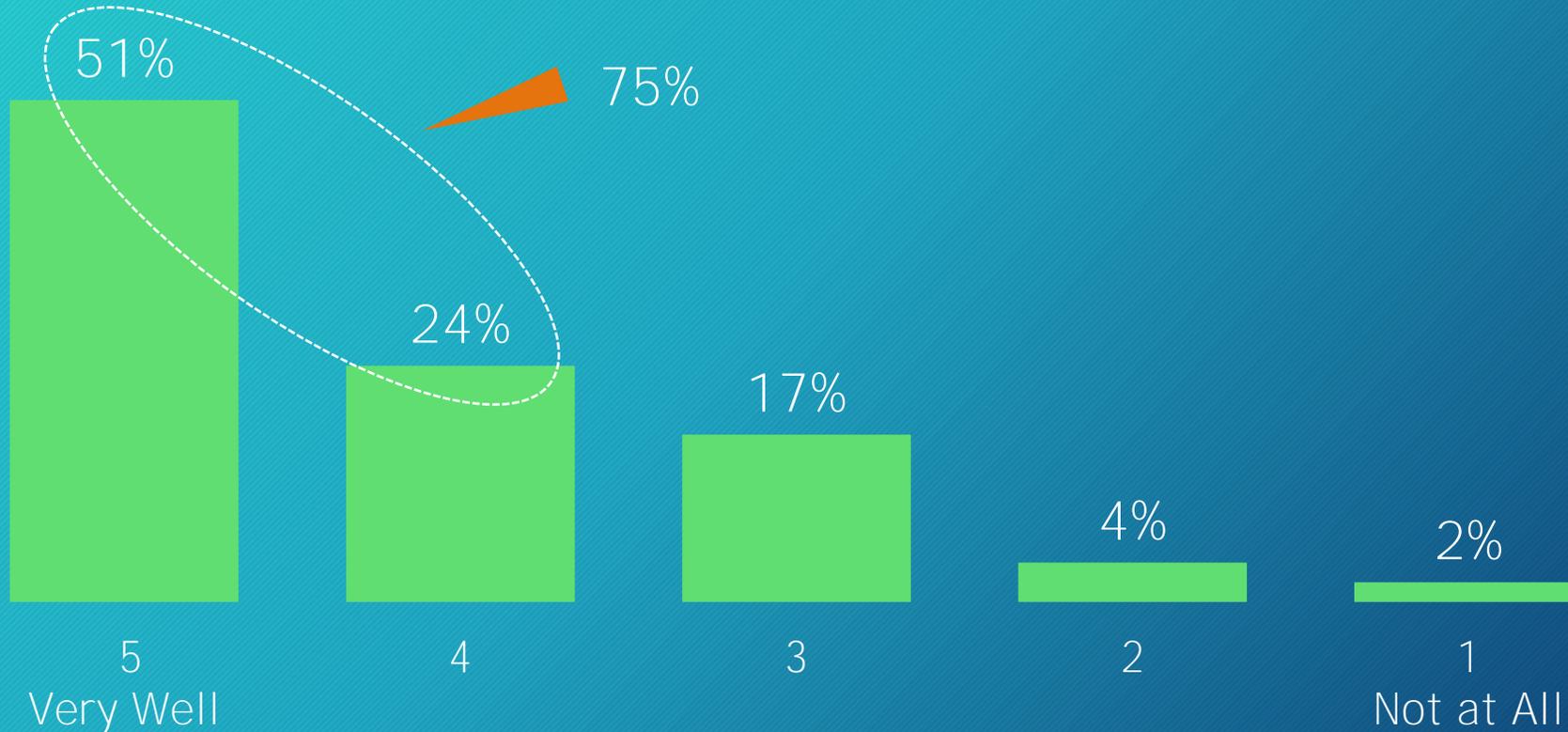
- Public Input at all 11 Supervisorial Districts (11 meetings)
 - Preliminary results from both structured survey and patron use analysis presented at meetings in October and November 2017
 - Members of the public had opportunity to ask questions and provide comments
 - All attendees invited to participate in Public Input Survey as well

Open Hours Assessment - Components (cont.)

- Patron Use Analysis
 - Data analysis of Library visitor traffic and computer use to present a composite view of library use at each hour for each library location
 - Included analysis of system-wide open hours coverage
 - Methodology, findings and recommendations **presented separately by the Controller's Office**

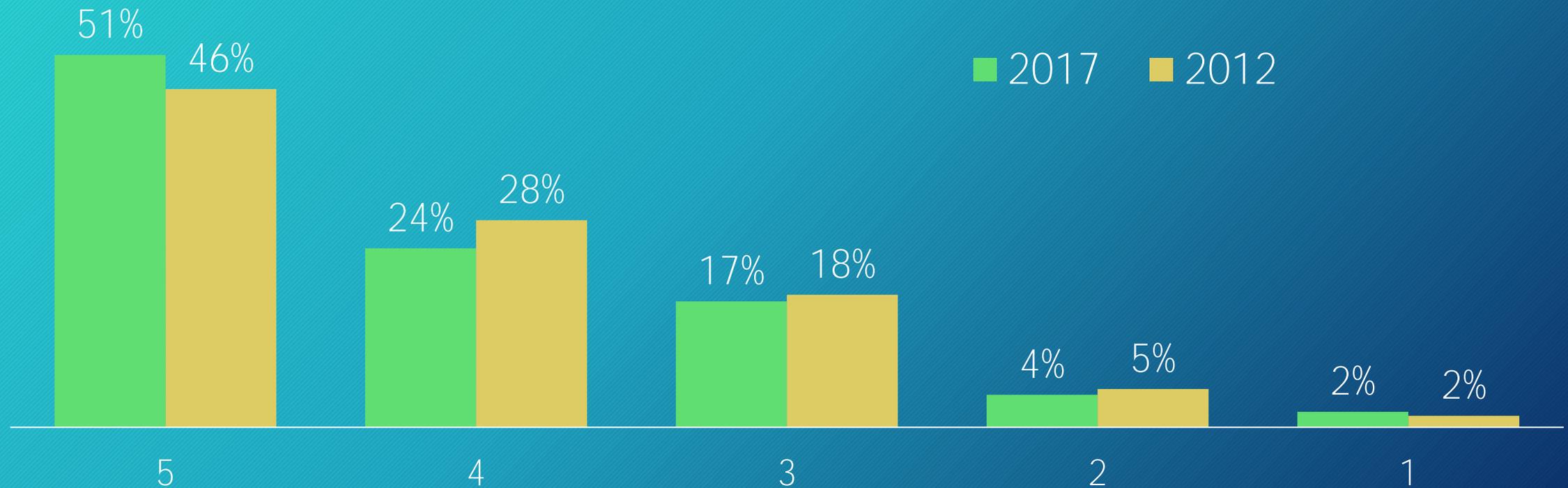
Results - Satisfaction with Open Hours

Note: 2% did not answer this question in 2017 and 1% did not answer this question in 2012

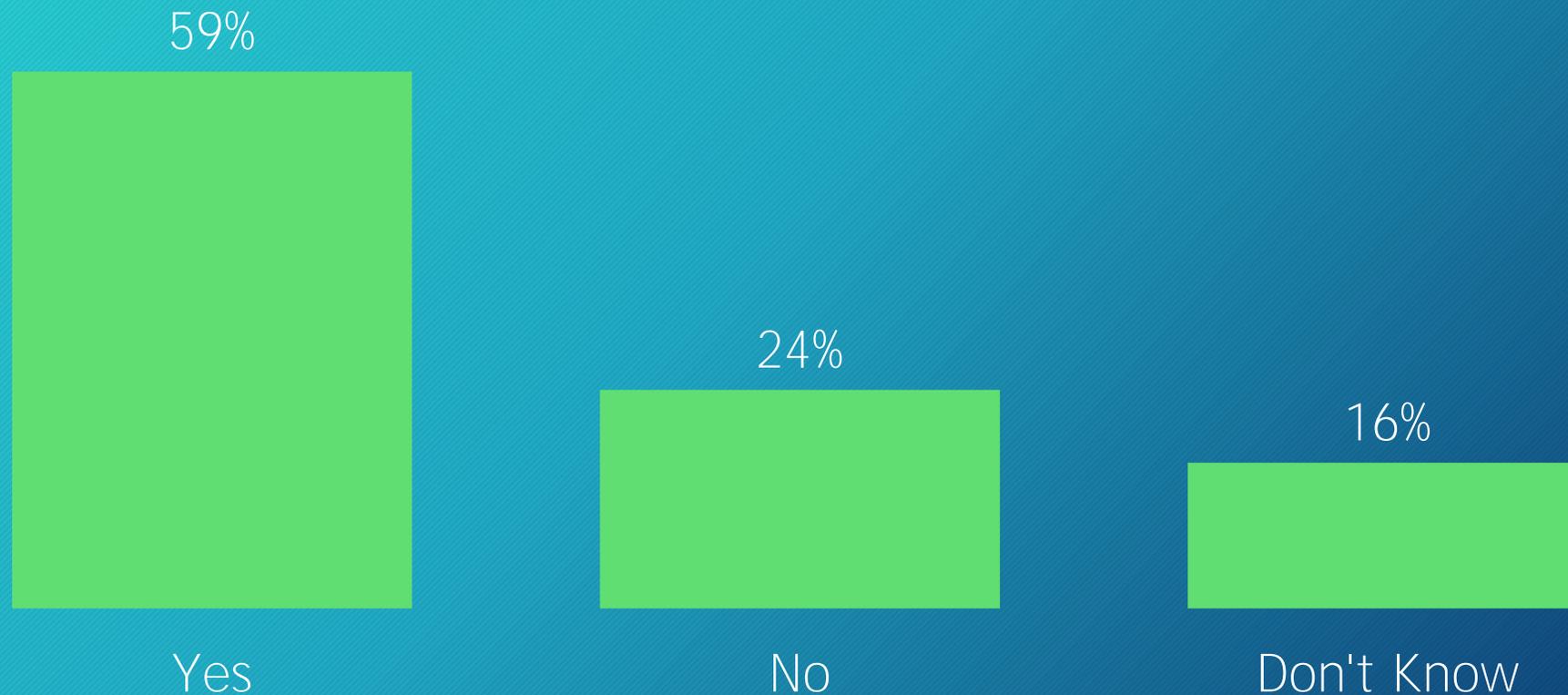

Results - Additional Hours

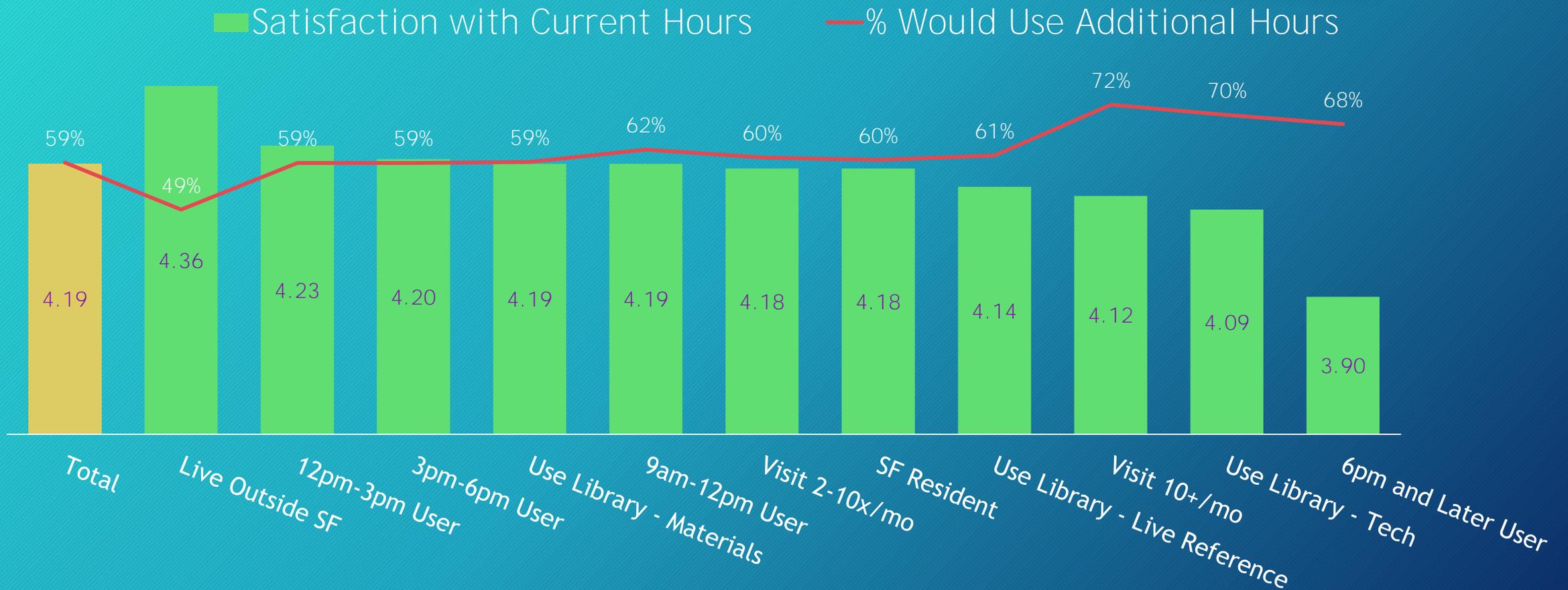
If this branch were open more hours, would you use it more?



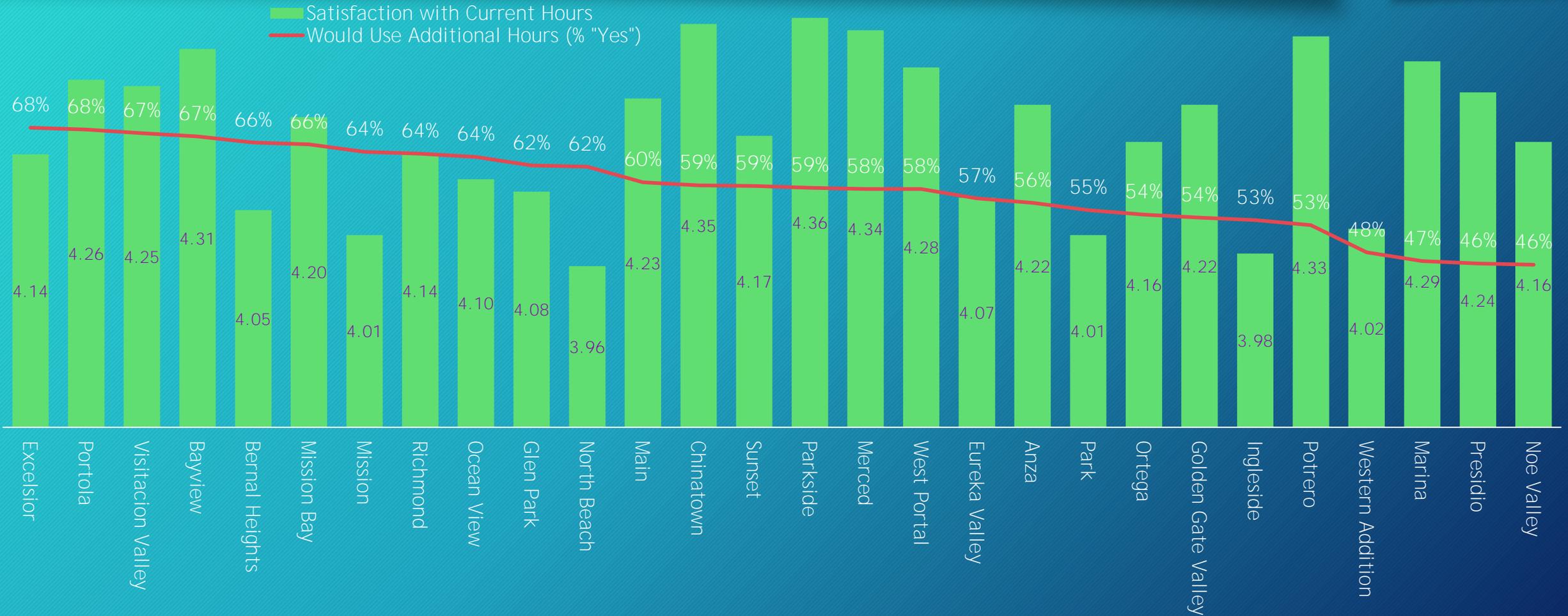
Results - Additional Hours (cont.)

- Although satisfaction with open hours is high, 59% indicated they would use the library more if it were open additional hours
- Lower satisfaction and a higher desire for additional hours, key among several sub-groups:
 - Those visiting the library after 6 pm
 - Those visiting the library to use technology
 - Frequent visitors (e.g. visit a library 10+ times/month)

Results - Timing of Additional Hours (cont.)

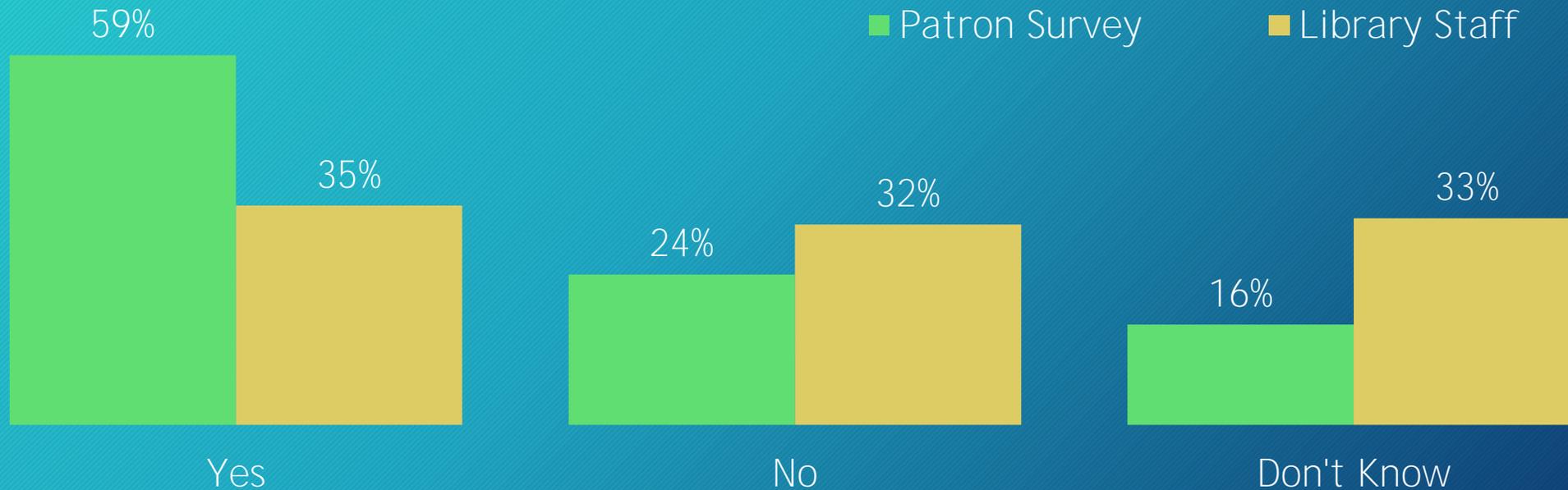
By branch, strongest desire for:

- Evening hours (only)
Main (44%), Marina (44%), Bayview (42%)
- Morning hours (only)
Marina (44%), Presidio (38%), Richmond (37%)
- Weekend hours (only)
Parkside (30%), Bernal Heights (29%), Anza (26%)
- Evenings and weekends
Presidio (17%), Western Addition (15%)

Patron Survey: If this branch were open more hours, would you use it more?

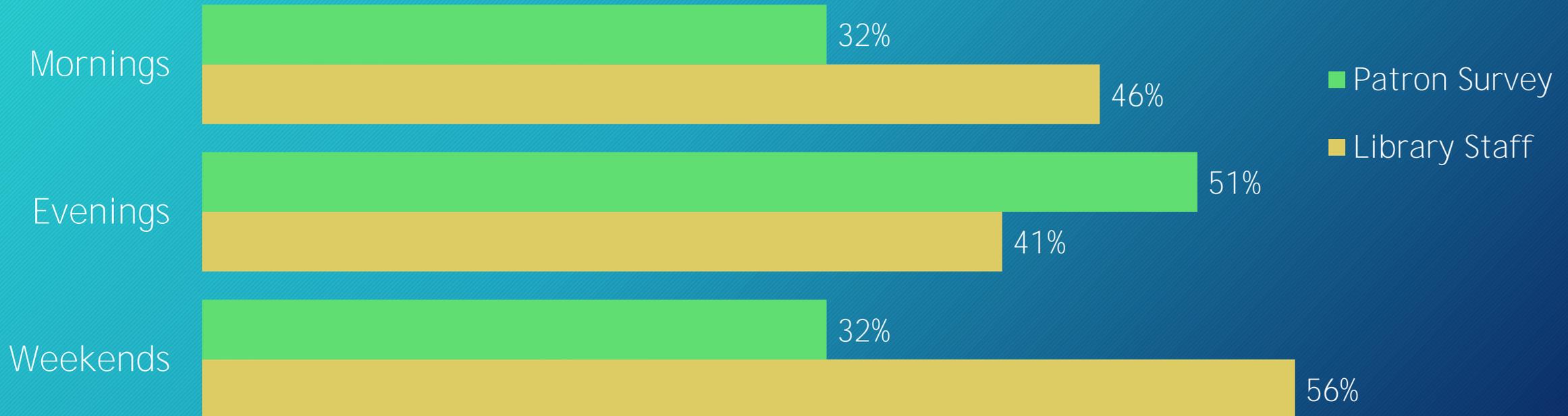
Library Staff Survey: If this library location were open more hours, do you feel a significant number of patrons would use it more?

Average number of minutes spent on typical visit (2017 vs. 2012)

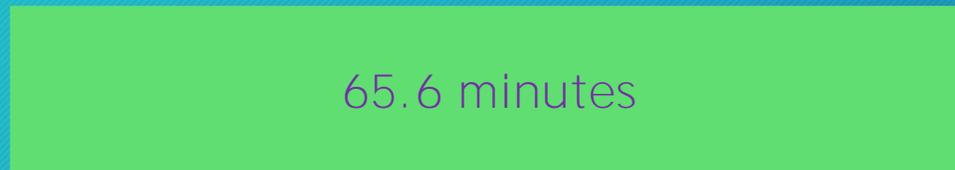
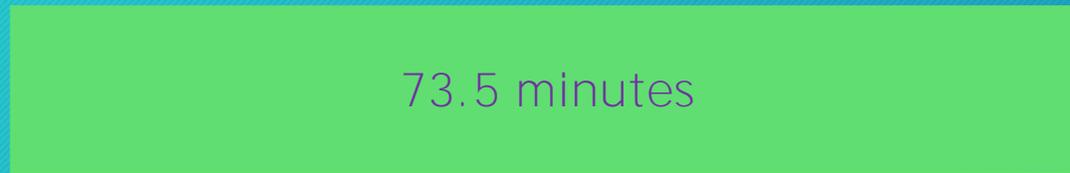

Summary of Findings

- Most (75%) are satisfied with existing hours
- More than half (59%) would use additional hours
- High demand for evening hours (patron survey), but existing evening hours across the Library system are not heavily used **(Controller's report, staff survey results)**.
 - Broad definition of evening
 - Lack of awareness of existing open hours
 - Hours vs. capacity
- Additional hours desire correlates with type of use
 - Technology use, visit 10+ times a month, use after 6pm

Recommendations

- If additional hours are considered:
 - Increase awareness of existing expanded hours
 - Consider measuring capacity and its impact on library use
 - Use detailed branch-specific profiles in report as guide
