

Marina Library to open

After 2-year renovation

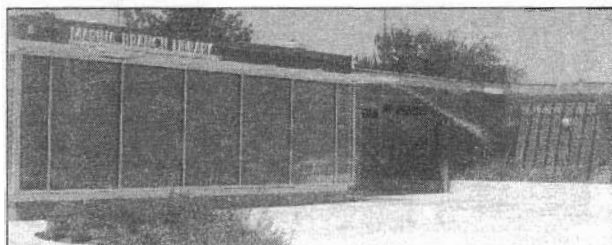
The city has announced that the Marina Library Branch will be re-opening after two years and \$3.9 million of renovation.

Lion dancers, musicians and kids entertainers will join in the celebration, which starts at 1 p.m. on Aug. 4, city officials said.

The library, located at 1890 Chestnut St., closed Sept. 2, 2005 to undergo a major renovation.

Marina is the fourth branch to be renovated under the Branch Library Improvement Program, which is funded by a \$105.9 million bond measure

kids' room, designated teen area and new restrooms. The library is seismically and technologically updated with new computers and free WiFi access. Project costs totaled \$3.9 million.
