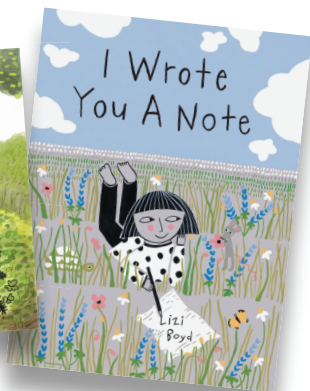


STORYWALKS IN THE PARK

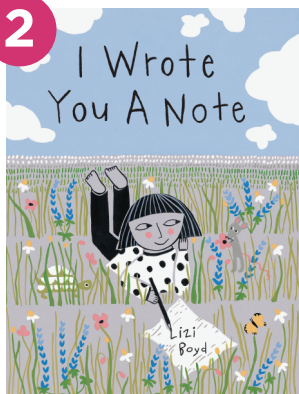
