Artists-in-Residence at SFPL

- Launched in September 2015, the Artist in Residence program is overseen by the San Francisco Arts Commission Galleries and is an ongoing program that seeks to build partnerships with a variety of City Departments in order to provide unique residency opportunities that result in strengthening the value of artists participating in the advancement of civic dialogue.
- Last year, SFPL hosted four artists: tanea lunsford lynx, Gazelle Samizay, Xandra Ibarra and James Q. Chan.
- On view March 11-June 18, 2023: Xandra Ibarra's series, *Of Ill Fame*, drew inspiration from historic SFPD mugshot books.
- Later this summer: *The Ink of Identity: Rereading Afghanistan* a multi-media installation by Gazelle Samizay.
- Projects by James Q. Chan and tanea lunsford lynx are still in development.


