• **80%** of Middle Ground visitors said the experience brought up feelings of compassion for people who were different from them








# Chapter 21 G

Chapter 21 G governs grants made by a City Department to a private entity and details our requirement. Chapter 21G.8(a) in part now reads:

For Granting Agencies under the jurisdiction of a commission or a board, the Granting Agency shall not award a Grant without conducting an open and competitive process unless the commission or board approves the Granting Agency's recommendation that the Grant be awarded as a sole source. Before awarding such a Grant, the Granting Agency shall recommend to the commission or board concerned the approval and award of a Grant pursuant to this subsection (a) and such commission or board may then adopt a resolution approving the justification of the sole source and awarding the Grant.



# Sole Source Recommendation

#### Competitive Solicitation Infeasible/Impractical

- Grant is to support an ongoing pilot program
- Grant will support the established relationship between Exploratorium and Urban Alchemy
- Changing partners now would be impractical

Staff recommends approval of the resolution to approve the award of this grant to

- Grantee: Urban Alchemy
- Amount: \$111,831
- Anticipated Dates: 3/1/2024 6/30/2024
