Researcher Confidentiality Agreement

The San Francisco Human Services Agency (SFHSA) transferred portions of its archives to the San Francisco Public Library for the purpose of public access for a variety of uses. These archives contain unique and valuable information about the history of low-income communities in San Francisco and the services provided to them.

To gain access to these archives, SFHSA and the San Francisco Public Library require that researchers agree to not disclose in any form the personally identifying information of SFHSA clients who might appear in these archival materials.

SFHSA also requires that researchers who publish findings based on its archives include the following disclaimer: "The archives of the San Francisco Human Services Agency have been made available for the purpose of historical research. The views contained in this publication represent the conclusions of the author and do not necessarily represent the views of the San Francisco Human Services Agency nor the City and County of San Francisco."
