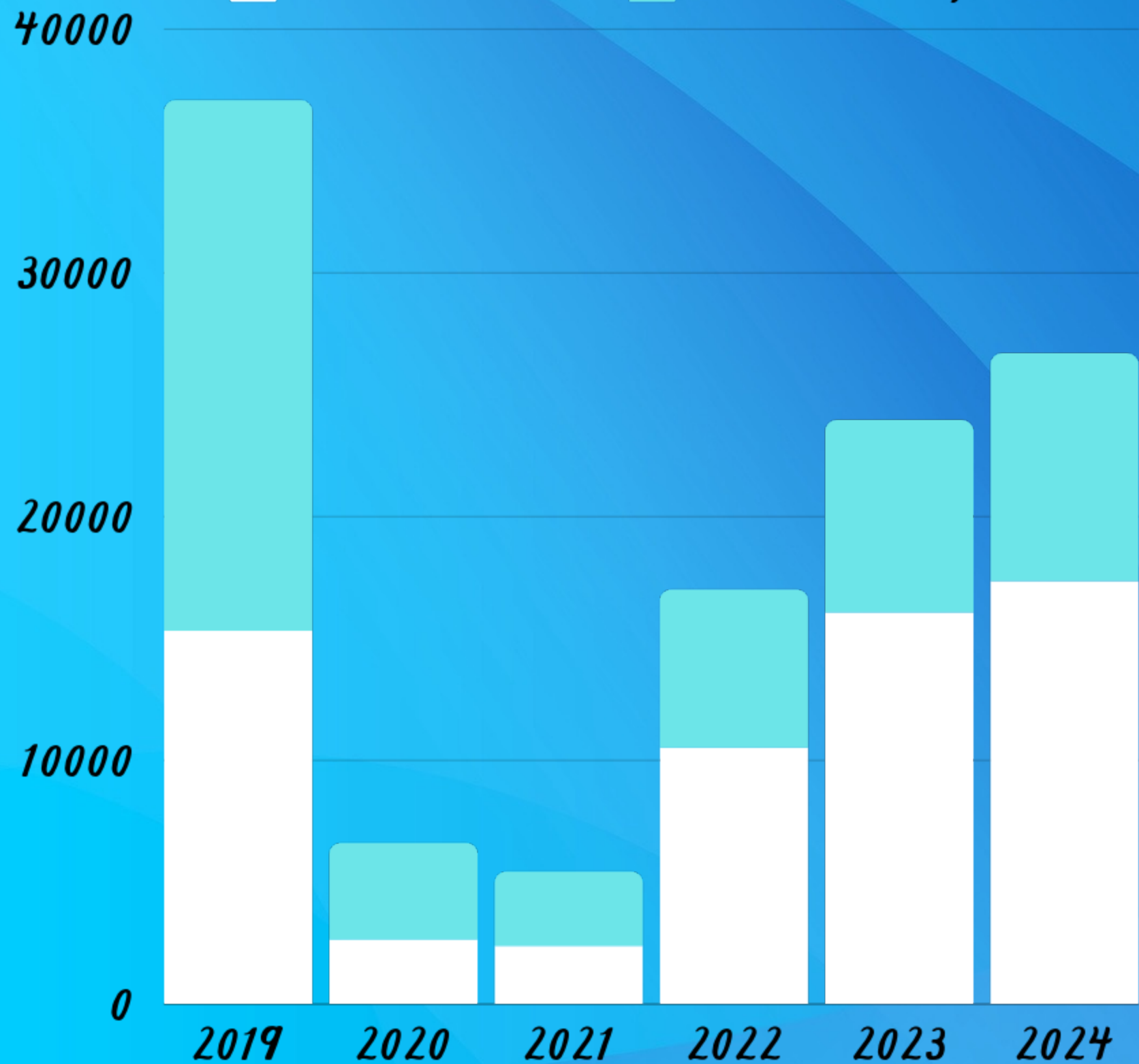

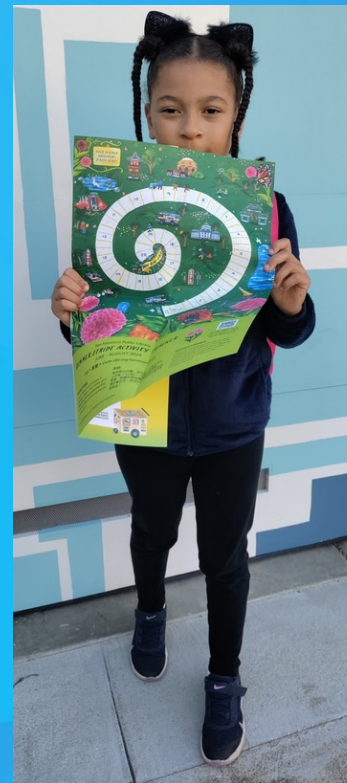
Everybody Reads

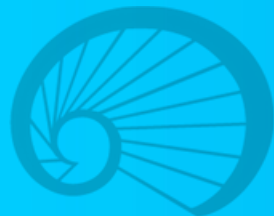
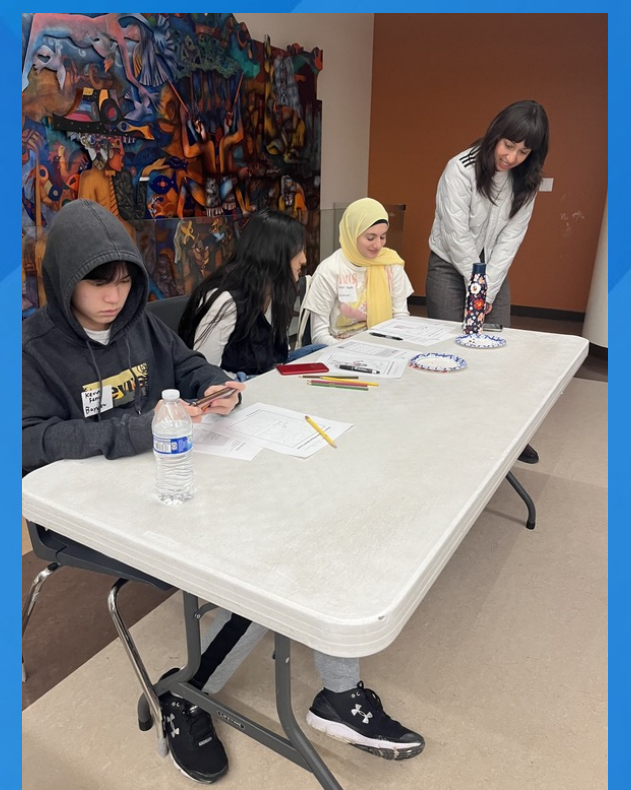
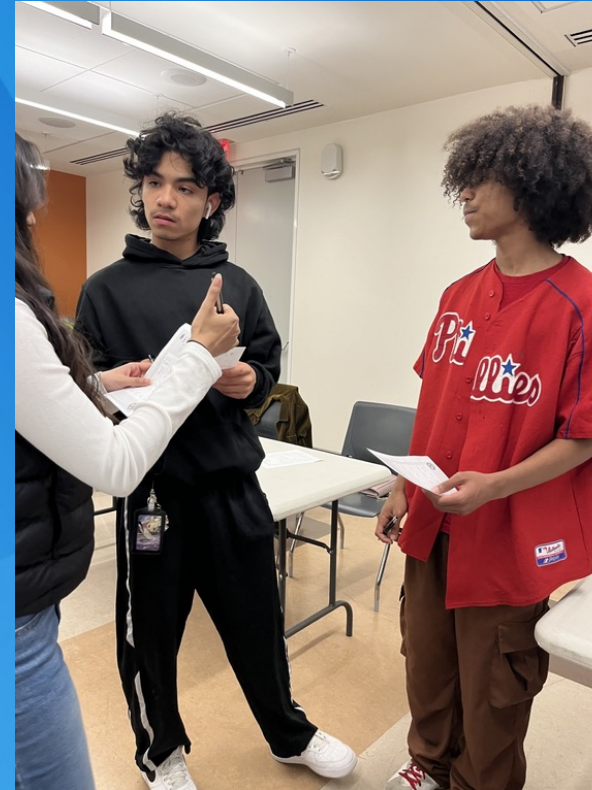
96% agreed that summer activities at the Library help motivate children to read and learn.
