Struggling Readers Need Your Help!

FOG Readers students are in grades 1st – 4th and need help breaking words apart, and reading with fluency.

What Tutors Teach

Tutors teach the FOG Readers curriculum that includes breaking words into chunks and building vocabulary.

Tutor Training

All tutors go through 7+ hours of training and one-time fingerprinting (at no cost to you). We prepare you to be an effective literacy tutor and also provide follow-up support.



Just Two Hours a Week

Tutors meet with a student at an SFPL branch library or online, once a week, for 45 minutes to 1 hour. Preparation for tutoring sessions is typically one hour. Tutoring sessions are scheduled around your availability and location preference. Includes evenings and weekends!
