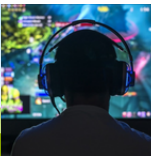

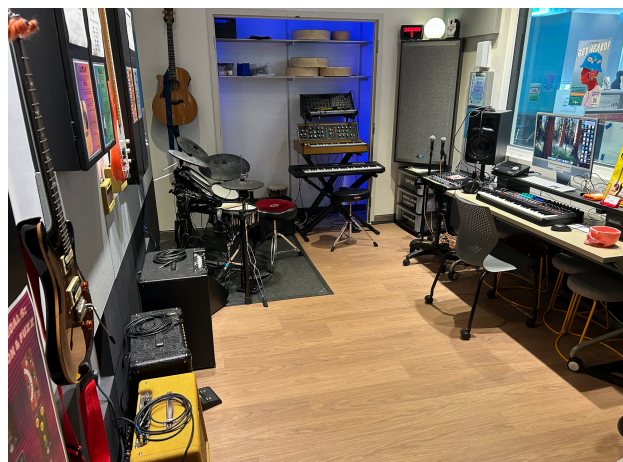
Studio A: Media
