












- Urban Libraries Council provides a forum for library leaders to share best practices and innovative ideas
- FOG Readers has been named a Top Innovator for 2018 in the Learning: Birth through Teens category!
- Ten top innovations were chosen by a panel of expert judges from almost 220 submissions

READING HELP AT THE LIBRARY

- Tutors and elementary school students meet one hour a week at a library location on an on-going basis
- Tutors follow a structured literacy program which uses an Orton Gillingham based methodology
- Focuses on alphabetic principle, phonics, decoding, spelling, fluency, accuracy, and comprehension skills
- 120 active tutor/student pairs at 23 of our 28 locations
