Main Library Elevator Upgrade

- The Main Library's public and staff elevators will undergo a complete upgrade of all mechanical and control systems
- Projected cost is \$4.5M for all Main Library elevators
- Five public and two staff elevators
- Huge improvement in reliability



Main Library Elevator Upgrade

- Scope of the Project
 - ✓ New controls and motors
 - ✓ Refurbishment of doors and cabs
 - ✓ Rebuilding of all mechanical components in hoistways
- Timeline
 - ✓ Bidding Summer 2018, completion one to two years
- Impact on public service and staff
 - ✓ Some delays will be unavoidable but will be minimized
 - ✓ If necessary staff elevators can be used to transport patrons
 - ✓ Increased messaging through signage, website, and social media








Jose Sarria Court Before and After Phase One
